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



The Allscripts Stimulus Program follows the Obama Administration's release of its long-awaited criteria for determining which Electronic Health Record (EHR) systems will qualify physicians for between \$44,000 and \$64,000 in Medicare and Medicaid incentive payments under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The law requires physicians to demonstrate their "meaningful use" of an EHR before they can claim the stimulus incentives, which first become available in 2011.
