



Dr. Piret Väli, Member of the Integrated Electronic Health Records Project Task Team, representative of the Board of the Estonian Dental Association, and past Vice-President of the Council of European Dentists (CED)

Dr. Piret Väli is a distinguished dentist from Estonia, actively contributing to national and international dental organizations. She has represented the Estonian Dental Association (EHL) as a delegate in the FDI Dental Parliament since 1996 and, in 2022, joined the FDI Integrated Electronic Health Records (EHR) Task Team.

Dr. Väli earned her degree in Dentistry from the University of Tartu in 1987. She established her first private practice in 1994 and currently practices at Clinic32 in Tallinn.

Her involvement with the Estonian Dental Association dates back to 1995, and in 1999, she became a board member. She served as President of the Association from 2006, dedicating nine years to leadership, including time as Vice President. She continues to serve as a Board Member today.

Beyond Estonia, Dr. Väli has played a significant role in European dentistry. Since 2000, she has represented the Estonian Dental Association in the Council of European Dentists (CED). She served on the Board of Directors (2004–2010) and later as Vice President (2016–2022). She also led the CED Working Group on E-Health from its establishment in 2011 until 2019 and chaired the Working Group on Dental Ethics (2006–2009). Additionally, she represented the CED at the European Commission's eHealth Stakeholders Group.

Dr. Väli is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists and a member of the Pierre Fauchard Academy. Her career has been dedicated to improving oral health and advancing integrated eHealth systems in Estonia. She remains committed to professional development initiatives.
