Room for More

Perhaps the feature that Dr. Pawelek and his team are most impressed by is the unit's large 11-inch chamber with 4 trays, which can accommodate up to 18 pounds of instruments.

"We're really impressed with the size of the trays," he said. "Our previous sterilizer had 2 large-sized trays and 2 smaller ones, but this unit has 4 large trays, which is much, much better. We can fit at least a quarter more than what we could in the past."

Maximize Your Maintenance

With no periodic cleaning cycles needed, the unit offers convenient automatic water filling and draining options, proactive maintenance reminders, and automated digital cycle records data. A single-use distilled water management system ensures fresh water is used for every cycle.

"The Maxima Advanced Chamber Sterilizer reminds you when to add water and when to drain it," Dr. Pawelek shared. "It's definitely much easier to maintain than our past units so far."
